Mental health concerns have been rising up the NHS agenda for a number of years, starting well before the pandemic made them even more urgent. The uncertainties of the present situation, short gloomy days and physical isolation exacerbated by the current lockdown are all contributing to higher levels of stress. This is true among many social groups including students, those facing unemployment, parents trying to balance work demands and home schooling, and especially the elderly living at home alone.

At this time last year we canvassed your opinions about topics for future talks and mental health in various forms came top of the list. We could not deliver on this request last year because of the lockdown and we suspect we may not be able to do so again this year. We have sought an online presentation on this subject but NHS staff are very busy at present. At aged 79 I was delighted to receive a text invitation to book a COVID-19 vaccination at the Harpenden Public Halls just over a week ago. Booking was easy by text and I duly arrived at the Public Halls at the pointed time.

The arrangements were excellent with the process organised smoothly with the support of numerous volunteers from Harpenden Trust. I received the first Pfizer jab for which I didn't experience any side effects. You are asked to sit for 15 minutes after the vaccination to make sure you do not react and this too was organised very efficiently. I understand that you do not need to wait after the AstraZeneca jab.

I would like to place on record my congratulations to all those who set up the local vaccination facility and those who are administering the process so efficiently.

I too have also appreciated the regular updates on the vaccination programme circulated by the Friends of Davenport House. A further one will be circulated shortly.

Standing Order donations in favour of Davenport House PPG

Many of you are continuing to "donate" to the Patient Group via a standing order which is credited to the former Davenport House PPG account. We transfer these amounts periodically to the new charity account, Friends of Davenport House.

The majority of the next standing order payments are due on 1 March 2021. It would greatly assist if you would complete a new standing order in favour of the new Charity using the authority overleaf at the same time cancelling your existing authority in favour of Davenport House PPG.

If you are a tax payer the form also provides the opportunity to Gift Aid your donation so that the Charity can claim a further 25p in the £ at no cost to you. If all standing order contributors were able to Gift Aid their donations it would generate a further £800 of income at no cost to the donors.
